Commissioner Meeting December 3, 2024

Chair Jerry Walsh called the meeting to order at 9:00 am. Commissioners John Hokana, Brandon Carlson, Kacey Holm, and Marke Roberts were also present. Auditor Sheppard and resident Cindy Bagley were also present. The media was not present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. States Attorney Kim Radermacher, County Agent Administrative Assistant Monica Pakonen, and the Dickey County Sheriff's Office joined the meeting via electronic means. Additions

Hokana made a motion to approve the minutes as amended. Holm seconded. Motion carried. Carlson made a motion to approve the vouchers as submitted. Roberts seconded. Roll call was unanimous. Motion carried.

Clerk of Court Andi Schimke joined the meeting at 9:25 to give the Commission an update on the locks on the buildings at Pheasant Lake. Schimke also stated the grant project upstairs is 99.9% complete. Schimke presented the applications to be submitted to Court Administration for next year's grant projects, that need to be signed by the Chair. Carlson made a motion to sign the grant applications. Holm seconded. Motion carried. A short recess was taken for Commission to look at the grant work completed on second floor of the courthouse.

Health District employee Allyssa Moch joined the meeting via electronic means at 9:17.

Walsh updated the Commission on the furnace problem at the Human Services office. Commission reviewed the quotes received from Climate Control. Possible grants for heating efficiency were also discussed. A decision was made to check with Rapid Response, based in Monango, to get a quote as well. Sheppard will have Administrative Assistant Amy Mittleider investigate possibly grant opportunities, in case the decision is made to replace the furnace.

Discussion followed concerning the Memorandum of Understanding presented to the Commission at the last meeting from the Red River Valley Water Supply Project. The amount of commitment that the Commission should make was discussed, but no decisions were made.

Sheriff Chris Estes joined the meeting at 10:05.

Carlson made a motion to open the bid opening for the 2017 Ford Intrepid. Holm seconded. Motion carried.

Three bids were received. The bids ranged from \$2,880 to \$3,501. Carlson made a motion to accept the high bid of \$3,501 from Jamie Nelson. Hokana seconded. Roll call was unanimous. Motion carried.

Holm made a motion to close the bid opening. Carlson seconded. Motion carried.

Sheppard presented a quote for office space in Oakes for the Veterans Service Office. Rent for the current space is paid in part by the Oakes American Legion, which has now closed. VSO Jean Haakenson is also concerned with the lack of privacy in the current space. The quote is for \$195 per month from RZ Properties. Holm made a motion to rent the office space from RZ Properties. Hokana seconded. Roll call was unanimous. Motion carried.

Tax Director Don Flaherty joined the meeting at 10:33.

Holm made a motion to open the abatement hearing. Carlson seconded. Motion carried. Flaherty presented a homestead credit application for a mobile home. Applicant is eligible for 100% credit for the 2024 tax year. Roberts made a motion to approve the application. Holm seconded. Roll call was unanimous. Motion carried.

Flaherty discussed with the Commission the primary residence credit for mobile homes that should be reimbursed to mobile homeowners. An abatement needs to be done since the payment of 2024 taxes on mobile homes has already been received. Holm made a motion to approve the abatements for the primary residence credit on mobile homes for 2024. Roberts seconded. Roll call was unanimous. Motion carried.

Carlson made a motion to close the abatement hearing. Holm seconded. Motion carried.

Flaherty requested the purchase of training hours from Vanguard in the amount of \$2,000 to be purchased before the end of 2024. Carlson made a motion to approve the purchase of training hours from Vanguard. Holm seconded. Motion carried.

Ellendale Mayor Don Flaherty informed the Commission that the city of Ellendale has received a request from Applied Digital to be annexed into the city of Ellendale. Discussion included the access from the city to the location and the maintaining of 87th Street. Flaherty stated the city will need to work with Ellendale Township on how that road will be maintained. Flaherty stated that this was not initiated by the city of Ellendale. No action was taken.

Mayor Flaherty explained the letter received from the city of Ellendale on the application for a tax exemption in the form of in lieu of taxes from the American Legion Post #137. Flaherty informed the

Commission that this action will not have any dollar effect for the county as the American Legion Post #137 is part of the Nodak Hotel tear down tax increment financing district.

Highway Superintendent Jeff Hagen joined the meeting at 10:53.

The meeting went into recess at 10:59 and returned at 11:05.

Hagen informed the Commission that Brown County Road Highway Superintendent Dirk Rogers has responded to the request for a formal agreement between Brown County and Dickey County that was made by ND DOT. States Attorney Radermacher had forwarded a possible agreement, which Rogers has asked for changes. Sheppard will forward the e-mail from Rogers' for Radermacher's review.

KLJ Engineer Bryan Tykwinski joined the meeting via electronic means at 11:35.

Tykwinski updated the Commission on the status of the hydrology study on 86th Street north of Oakes, which has not been finalized. Tykwinski stated it will have several options for the project. The project has been submitted for flexible spending funding, along with the pavement of County Road 3 east of Oakes.

Sheppard reminded the Commission of the 5-County meeting on December 12th in Rutland, ND. The meeting went into recess for lunch at 12:05.

The Commission returned at 1:30 for a meeting with First District Association of Local Government, South Central Dakota Regional Council, and the Dickey County Zoning Board. In attendance from First District Association were Todd Kays, Luke Muller, Ryan Hartley, Amy Arnold, and Kelli Henricks. In attendance from South Central Dakota Regional Council were Traci Redlin and Jennifer Schultes. In attendance from the Zoning Board were Wes Knutson, Michelle Mueller, Brandon Gunn, Matt Herman, and Cindy Bagley. Also in attendance were States Attorney Kim Radermacher, Administrative Assistant Amy Mittleider, Ellendale Township Supervisor Joel Hamar and ND Department of Agriculture Haylee Viger.

A grant was given by the ND Department of Agriculture for site analysis to be completed for review of possible locations in counties to assist in livestock development planning. This analysis could be used in conjunction with the comprehensive plan currently being worked on by South Central Dakota Regional Council.

A presentation was given by First District Association of Local Government on the rural development site analysis completed by First District Association on Dickey County. Their findings were presented. The final report should be e-mailed to Dickey County by the end of next week. No action was taken. The analysis will be reviewed once the final report is received.

Holm made a motion to adjourn at 3:00.

Carlson received a call from Fullerton Farmers Elevator concerning County Road 3C west of Fullerton. A decision was made to consider placing DustPods on that road. Fullerton Farmers Elevator will attend the January 21st meeting during Highway time to discuss the road.

Holm made a motion to approve the December 3rd minutes with corrections. Roberts seconded. Motion carried.

Health District Administrator Roxanne Holm joined the meeting at 9:10 via electronic means. Holm made a motion to approve the vouchers as submitted. Carlson seconded. Roll call was

unanimous. Motion carried.

Hokana made a motion to approve the November 2024 financial. Holm seconded. Roll call was unanimous. Motion carried.

Dickey County Sheriff's Office joined the meeting at 9:20 via electronic means.

Carlson updated the Commission on the 5-County meeting held December 12th in Rutland, ND. Items of discussion were the county jail project in Richland County, the dairy in Richland County, LoadPass, and the reorganization of the Board. The next meeting will be hosted in Dickey County, after legislative session is completed.

County Agent Administrative Assistant Monica Pakonen and Health District Office Manager Kerry Waldo joined the meeting via electronic means at 9:25.

County Agent Breana Kiser and Pakonen informed the Commission of the hiring of Kasi Holm to fill the Family and Community Wellness position, starting May 27, 2025.

Based on the upcoming approval of the local permit application by the North Dakota Attorney General's office, Holm made a motion to approve the local permit application for the Oakes Sno Busters and to waive the fee. Roberts seconded. Roll call was unanimous, with Carlson abstaining.

Mittleider informed the Commission that Dickey County has been approved by the North Dakota Historical Society for the cleaning of the outside of the Courthouse. The project will need to be completed by August 2026. Mittleider will contact the vendor to ensure that Dickey County is on their schedule for 2026. Holm made a motion to accept the grant. Carlson seconded. Roll call was unanimous. Motion carried.

Walsh updated the Commission on the South Country Human Services Zone meeting held December 16th. The zone plans to purchase two cars. In January, Representative Jim Grueneich will need to be reappointed to the Board for another term. Discussion included the furnace replacement at the Human Services office in Dickey County. Mittleider is currently working on a grant to help with the cost of the replacement.

Garrison Diversion General Manager Duane DeKrey, Garrison Diversion Board Vice-Chair and Southeast Water Users board member Jay Anderson, and Burian Associations representative Steve Burian, joined the meeting at 9:45.

Sheppard stated a joint meeting with the LaMoure County Commissioners needs to be scheduled, concerning the organization of the LaMoure Fire District. After discussing dates that fit the requirement given in North Dakota Century Code, the dates of January 13, 14, or 15th should work. Sheppard will inform the Commission of the final date and time once it is coordinated with the LaMoure County Auditor.

Dickey County Water Resource Board Chair Steve Hansen and Oakes Enhancement Inc. Chair Jeff Forward joined the meeting at 9:58.

Hansen reported to the Commission on the letter given to the County Treasurer concerning the protesting of specials for the Drain #11. As stated by both the Water Resource Board Attorney and States Attorney Radermacher, these specials cannot be protested. A notice will be posted on Facebook as well as the Treasurer's office stating the Century Code.

DeKrey, Anderson, and Burian discussed with the Commission updates on the Red River Valley Water Project. Burian provided updated numbers for the Commission to review. Discussion followed concerning the amount of water the County would consider. Burian reminded the Commission that the Memorandum of Commitment is non-binding. Anderson also stated that there have been conversations with Senator Hoven, which may bring additional financing to the project from the Federal government. There is no commitment of funds for three years, with a ramp up of full payment to start after five years. Hansen feels that we should commit to as much as we can. Hansen also suggested developing cooperative agreements with other companies/political subdivisions within the area. Walsh asked for a motion. Carlson made a motion to commit to 3.2 cfs. Hokana seconded. In discussion, Roberts felt that Dickey County should be closer to 4 cfs. Carlson amended his motion to change the amount from 3.2 cfs to 4 cfs. Roll call was unanimous. Motion carried.

KLJ Engineer Bryan Tykwinski, Highway Superintendent Jeff Hagen, RDO Equipment representative Shane Glover, and Summit Carbon Solutions representative Charlie Adams joined the meeting at 10:55.

The meeting went into recess at 11:01 and returned at 11:05.

Adams reported on the status of the carbon pipeline. The permits in North Dakota have been approved by the Public Service Commission. Minnesota and Iowa permits have also been approved. South Dakota has not been approved. Adams stated that road crossing permits will need to be worked on. Adams stated that construction will most likely start in 2026. Adams stated the percent of voluntary easements for Dickey County has not changed since last discussed.

Glover presented information compiled by his office on the status of our motor grader machines and the warranty on the machines. Discussion included switching blades between routes or changing routes to lighten the load on some of the motor grader machines so they do not exceed the warranty hours. All agreed that the machines should be serviced yearly as well as right before the machine comes off warranty.

Tykwinski gave a report on the status of prairie dog funding. This funding should be received in March approximately. Discussion followed concerning the plan for 2025. Tykwinski will bring a map to the January 21st meeting for discussion.

Hagen reported that Bookkeeper Lauri Uecker has left her position. After some discussion, a decision was made to have the Auditor's office and the Treasurer's office pick up the work instead of hiring a new person.

The meeting went into recess for lunch at 11:59.

The meeting came back in session at 1:03. South Central Dakota Regional Council staff Traci Redlin and Jennifer Schultes, Invenergy Tyler Suazo and Gregory Stanek, residents Alan Gramlow and

Keith Kronberg were in attendance. Members of the zoning board that were in attendance were Michelle Mueller, Matt Herman, Brandon Gunn, Jeff Forward, Cindy Bagley, and Sean "Wes" Knutson.

A review of the comprehensive plan was done, noting changes that need to be made. Schultes will make the changes as requested. Hokana made a motion to accept the comprehensive plan with the changes discussed. Carlson seconded. Roll call was unanimous. Motion carried.

The Zoning Board will meet right after the Commission meeting is adjourned. Holm made a motion to adjourn at 1:58.
