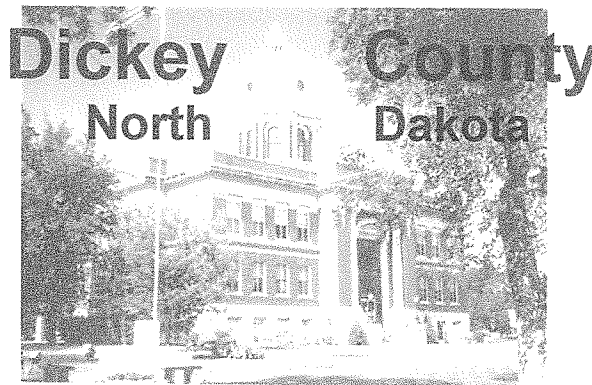

**Dickey County Redistricting Board to hold Public Hearing**

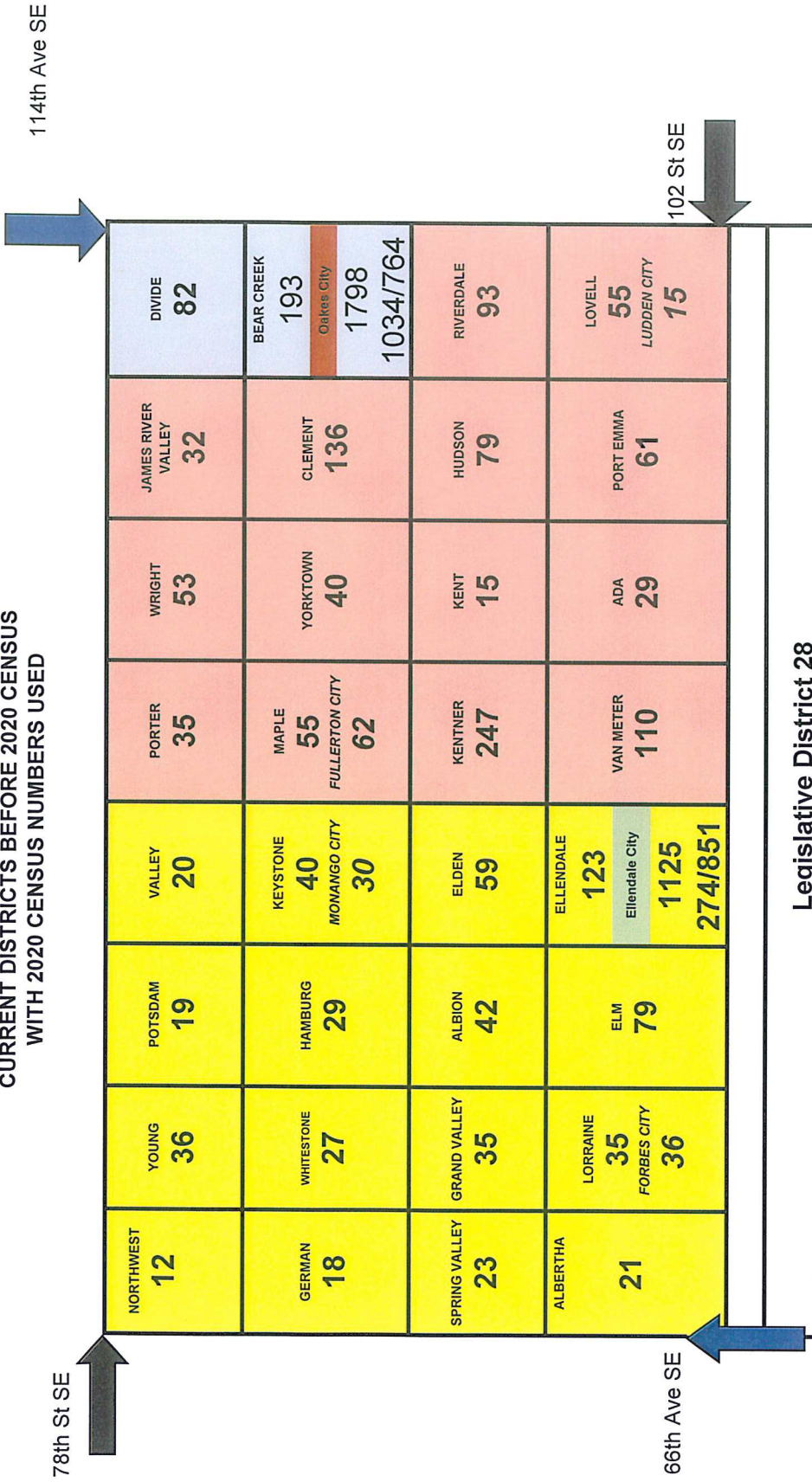
The Dickey County Redistricting Board will hold a public hearing to present a plan for redistricting County Commission Districts on Tuesday, November 30 at 10:00 am in the Dickey County Commission Room. Public comment regarding the plan will be accepted in-person during the hearing or through comments submitted to the Auditors office by close of business November 29<sup>th</sup>.

Redistricting of County Commission Districts occur after each federal decennial census. Per ND Century Code Chapter 11-07, counties that have at least one County Commission District that deviates more than 10% from the average population per commissioner as determined by dividing the total population of the county from the most recent census (Census 2020) by the number of commission districts in the county must redistrict. Dickey County meets the criteria for redistricting in 2021.

Dickey County currently has 5 Commission Districts. Based on the 2020 Census, the population of Dickey County is 4,999. The boundaries of each district need to be redrawn to redistribute the County’s decreasing population so that each district has a population as close to 1,000 as possible, with a margin of +/- 10%. Commissioner Districts 1, 2, and 3 need to be redrawn, while Districts 4 and 5 will not need to be redrawn.

WITH 2020 CENSUS NUMBERS USED**

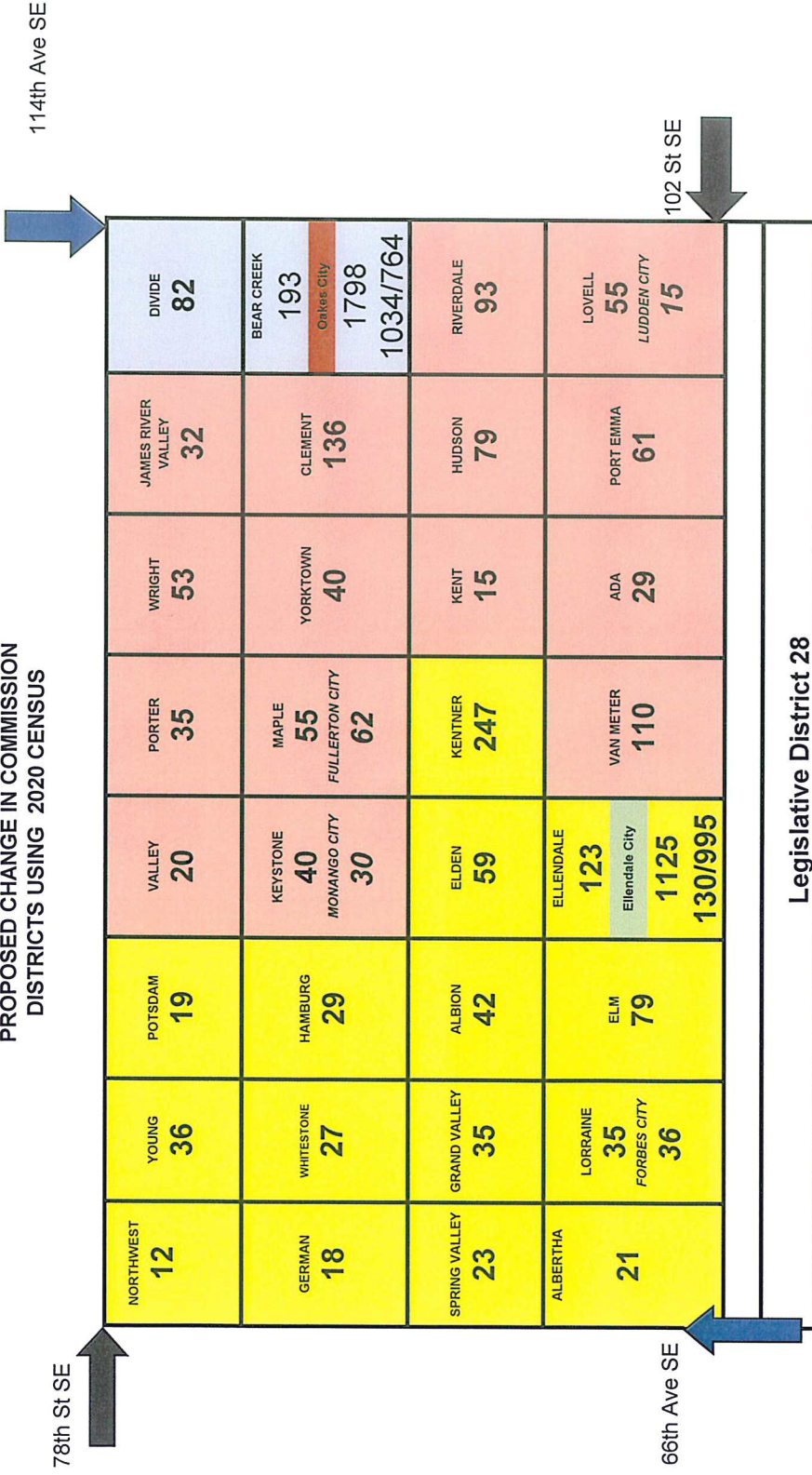
